Antimicrobial Resistance in the Food Chain

This film formed part of a MOOC about antibiotics, food and farming, and how antimicrobial resistance will affect our lives in the future. Judges commented that the production was an accessible and effective way of communicating important lessons about antibiotic resistance to a broad audience.

COLT – The Collaborative Learning Tool for Prevent

This online resource was produced to support the understanding of the CONTEST Prevent Strategy that aims to stop people being drawn into terrorism. The judges were impressed by the time and care that was taken during the film's production and noted that the video clips were well integrated into the online resource.

Reach Out Reporter

This fun online resource provides primary teachers with topical science films and resources to engage their students, highlighting the latest news and current issues in science. Judges described this production as a valuable classroom resource and praised the range of easily accessible films available for teachers to use.

An engaging online teaching resource bringing the campaign for women's voting rights to life. Users follow the journey through video, audio and interactive activities, starting with the first mass petition in 1866.
